Shanmuhadas in August 1980. It is permanently affiliated to the National Council for Vocational Training of the Govt. of India. This Institute is owned and run by the St. Joseph's Province of the Little Flower Congregation (CST Fathers)

Vision

1. To impart technical training programmes to girls and boys especially to the less fortunate one and thus qualifying them for skilled work to earn their livelihood;
2. To eradicate the problem of unemployed by enabling them to find self-employment by enabling them to find self-employment;

Admission

Admission is open to both girls and boys. The candidates must be physically fit to undergo the training. 10% of the seats are reserved for SC&ST. Application for admission should be sent in the prescribed form available at the cost of Rs.100/-from the office of the institute. The institute reserves the right to reject an application without assigning any reason. Selection will be made on the basis of aptitude and personal interview. The authorities of the Institute reserve to themselves the right to dismiss at any time and at their own discretion students who are found to be unsuitable whether due to bad conduct or lack of a sufficient progress in training. The students will have no claim for the fees have paid if any, when they leave the institute on their own accord or by dismissal.

Age Limit and Qualification

In general minimum age for admission is 15 years and maximum should not be more than 40 at the time of admission. Preferable qualification for NCVT training in our Institutes is Class XII but minimum qualification for NCVT is SSLC pass.

Working Hours

Classes will be between 7 am to 5 pm (according to the time table). However a trainee will not have to stay in the Institute for more than 8 hours a day.

Uniform

Prescribed Uniform of the Institute is compulsory for the trainees and it has to be kept neat and tidy. Long hair for boys, shabby dress, and overgrown beard are not permissible.

Holidays & Leaves

There is no vacation for the trainees other than the government declared holidays. Maximum 12 casual leaves are allowed in a year. Institute has the right to collect fine for the extra leaves.

Award of Certificates

A trainee who passes the All India Trade Test will be awarded the National Trade Certificate issued from the Ministry of labour, Govt. of India.

Syllabus

The syllabus approved by the Govt. Which includes Trade Practical, Trade Theory, Engineering Drawing, Workshop Calculation and Science and Employability skills will be strictly followed. The medium of instruction will be English.

Draughtsman Civil
